
**1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funding as matching funds for qualified non-profits that participated in the 2010 Race 4 Humanity.**

**BACKGROUND:**

**Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the local-community organizations dedicated to serving the public. The organizations will use the County funds to improve the quality of life of local residents.**

**Community Improvement Designation funds given to these organizations will be used for the following purposes:**
