RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for the 6th Annual Gala at the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens; and
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to adjust appropriations, estimated revenue and designations as follows:

Decrease Designation: 320135-10000-100010000 0	Community Improvement	\$25,000
Increase Appropriations: 551100-10000-100010000 0	Contribution to other Co. Funds	\$25,000
Increase Estimated Revenue: 790600-32710-1900100000	Contributions from other Co. Funds	\$25,000
Increase Appropriations: 536200-32710-1900100000	Contribution to Non-Co Agency	\$25,000

BACKGROUND: The Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens is a County museum and cultural resource. The annual gala event raises funds for much-needed rehabilitation and restoration of the grounds and facilities. This use of Community Improvement Designation funds allows staff to pay for the event with the funds that are raised used for the restoration and rehabilitation.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$25,000 to support the ongoing needs at the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens.
