BACKGROUND: The state's ongoing fiscal crisis threatens to undermine plans for UCR School of Medicine, a resource Riverside County desperately needs. Riverside County faces mounting health care problems. Potential closures of the two main hospitals in southwestern Riverside County and financial troubles at hospitals in Riverside and Hemet jeopardize residents' access to quality medical care. The UCR School of Medicine, set to open in 2010, would provide infrastructure needed to protect Riverside County residents' health, safety and welfare for generations to come.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$100,000 to support the University of California, Riverside School of Medicine.
