DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY TAX REVENUE TO BE EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE BANNING LIBRARY DISTRICT AND THE BEAUMONT LIBRARY DISTRICT REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATION TO BANNING LIBRARY DISTRICT AND CONCURRENT DETACHMENT FROM THE BEAUMONT LIBRARY DISTRICT (PARCELS 1&2), AND ANNEXATION TO BEAUMONT LIBRARY DISTRICT AND CONCURRENT DETACHMENT FROM THE BANNING LIBRARY DISTRICT (PARCEL 3) LAFCO 2009-15-5

WHEREAS, the Banning Library District has filed LAFCO No. 2009-15-5 requesting a reorganization to include annexation to Banning Library District and concurrent detachment from the Beaumont Library District (parcels 1&2), and annexation to Beaumont Library District and concurrent detachment from the Banning Library District (parcel 3), and

WHEREAS, Revenue and Taxation code Section 99(b)(5) directs the Board of Supervisors to negotiate any exchange of Property Tax revenues that affect the service responsibility of one or more special districts, and

WHEREAS, the responsibility for providing library services will rest with the Beaumont Library District and the Banning Library District per the new proposed boundaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors assembled in regular session on _____, 2010, that:

- 1. The Banning Library District and the Beaumont Library District are the agencies whose area of responsibility would be affected by LAFCO 2009-5-15.
- 2. The Banning Library District shall assume the responsibility for all library services within the territory sought to be detached from the Beaumont Library District (parcels 1&2) and for such service shall receive a 100% percentage of that portion of the property tax revenue generated within the territory to be detached that relates to library services; however, the transfer shall be phased in according to the following schedule:

- 3. The Beaumont Library District shall assume the responsibility for all library services within the territory sought to be detached from the Banning Library District (parcel 3) and for such service shall receive a 100 percent of that portion of the property tax revenue generated within the territory to be detached that relates to library services.
- 4. The County Auditor shall convert the above-established percentage into actual dollar figures and thereafter allocate such property tax revenue in accord with the provisions of Section 95 et seq. of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
- 5. The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to each affected agency and to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission and to the Auditor of the County of Riverside pursuant to Section 99 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
