BACKGROUND: The County Library provides library services to the community of Anza through a joint use library at Hamilton High School, operated in conjunction with Hemet Unified School District. This arrangement has been in place since 1998. On-going library operations are arranged by the County Librarian and maintained with oversight by the County Librarian. Hemet Unified School District provides facilities maintenance services for the Anza Library. This Agreement keeps the same terms and extends the Agreement for an additional year to June 30, 2011, at a cost of \$20.80 per hour, for a total of \$21,632.
