

SUBJECT: Approval of Stratus Technologies as a Sole Source Vendor to Provide

Annual Maintenance of Equipment Supporting RMS and CLETS

## **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve and authorize the Purchasing Agent to renew the existing agreement with Stratus Technologies for hardware and software maintenance for equipment supporting RMS (Records Management System) and CLETS (California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System), in the annual amount of \$67,260, without securing competitive bids, in accordance with Ordinance 459.4.
- 2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to renew the contract annually for up to three (3) additional one year periods, provided funds are appropriated and cost increases do not exceed the CPI.

In 1998, as part of its migration from IBM system to the current RMS system, the Sheriff's Department purchased hardware and software components (message switch) from Stratus Technologies. This switch is the only connection to the Department of Justice, FBI, NCIC, and the only means of operation to provide CLETS information to Sheriff's personnel, contract cities, police departments and other County agencies.

This switch moves transactions between the Sheriff's RMS system and the requesting agency terminal. The hardware and software support approximately 3,000 devices including RMS terminals and MDC's. Staff includes 40% of the Stratus Technologies annual charge in the RMS rate calculation, and approximately 61% of that is recovered from contract cities and other governmental agencies. The RMS rate recovers approximately 24% of the annual costs.

The hardware and software maintenance agreement covers software updates and upgrades, and hardware repair or replacement. The switch has proven to be both stable and reliable.

On 7/21/09 (3.77), the Board approved a renewal of Stratus Technologies' sole source status for five years contingent upon the company's annual maintenance fee increases not exceeding that of the CPI. Stratus has exceeded local CPI with its FY 10-11 support fee hike from \$63,000 to \$67,260. However, the Sheriff's Department RMS operating scenario has not changed; the Stratus hardware and software are proprietary, and there are no other vendors who can provide this service for the existing equipment. So the Department recommends continuing the Stratus maintenance agreement with adjusted cost limits.

## **Price Reasonableness**

In 1998, the original software and equipment purchased from Stratus Technologies totaled \$491,225.00. The annual maintenance cost is approximately 13.7% of the original cost, which is at the lower end of the typical cost for maintenance. Note also that if the County remits payment by 7/31/10 we will receive a 3% discount (\$2,017.80).
