RE: Amendment No. 2 to the On-Call Environmental Services Agreement with URS Corporation.

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between the County and URS Corporation on August 29, 2006 to provide the Transportation Department with the needed services. This amendment exercises the option in the agreement to extend the term of the contract for the first of the two optional one-year extensions. The Transportation Department needs the continued services of the URS Corporation.

The contract allows consultant rates to increase up to 5% per year after the first year. Rate increases of 5% were allowed in Year 2 and Year 3. Contract rates were not increased in Year 4 as part of Amendment #1. They were held at Year 3 rates. URS Corporation has agreed to reduce rates an additional 5% from Year 3 rates for Amendment #2. All associated contract costs will be funded using project funds. Thus, no net county costs will be incurred as a result of this contract amendment.

**AMENDMENT No. 2 TO AGREEMENT**

**for On-Call Environmental Services**

**between County of Riverside – Transportation Department**

**and URS Corporation**

THIS AMENDMENT (hereinafter the "Amendment") to an agreement is made and entered into as of this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2010, by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter the "COUNTY"), and URS Corporation, doing business as URS Corporation Americas (hereinafter "CONSULTANT").

**RECITALS**

- A. COUNTY and CONSULTANT have entered in an agreement entitled "On-Call Environmental Services between County of Riverside – Transportation Department and URS Corporation that is dated August 29, 2006 (hereinafter the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides the terms and conditions, scope of work, schedule and budget for the performance of professional and technical services necessary to provide on-call Environmental services.
- B. Appendix B • Article BI establishes the time period for allowing work assignments to be authorized under the original agreement. The terms and conditions specify that work assignment can be authorized for three years from the date of Board of Supervisors agreement approval (August 29, 2006) and that the authority to execute work assignments can be modified through one-year supplemental extensions. The agreement allows for two separate one-year extensions. The CONSULTANT is satisfactorily performing the duties under this agreement and the Transportation Department continues to need the services provided. The parties therefore now desire to implement the second one-year extension of the authority to execute work assignments.
- C. The County of Riverside – Transportation Department intends to modify the term of the contract extension to coincide with the fiscal year, July 1-June 30.

**AGREEMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows, effective July 1, 2010:

1. CONSULTANT agrees to a 5% reduction of current rates for the term of this agreement. CONSULTANT

1  
2 will use Year 3 rates but deduct 5% from each invoice. The 5% reduction does not apply to direct  
3 expenses.

4 2. The authority to authorize work assignments under this contract is hereby extended from July 1, 2010 to  
5 June 30, 2011 in accordance with Appendix B - Article BI of the original agreement.


6 3. Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and  
7 conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.


