SUBJECT: LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND THE REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN-SPACE DISTRICT FOR THE JURUPA VALLEY AQUATIC CENTER – District II

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board approves and:

- 1. Authorizes the attached Lease Agreement between the Riverside County Redevelopment Agency (RDA) and the Regional Park and Open-Space District (Park District) for use of the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center;
- 2. Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to execute said Lease Agreement;
- Authorizes the Park District's General Manager or designee to execute and take all
  actions necessary to implement the Lease Agreement including signing subsequent,
  necessary related documents to complete this transaction; and

4. Authorizes the Park District's General Manager or designee to execute amendments to extend the terms of the lease.

**SUBJECT:** LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY

REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND THE REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN-SPACE DISTRICT FOR THE JURUPA VALLEY AQUATIC

**CENTER - District II** 

The Park District desires to lease the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center, located at 4310 Camino Real, Riverside, California, from RDA to conduct programs which provide swimming activities to the unincorporated community of Jurupa.

RDA prepared a Negative Declaration for Environmental Assessment No. 2008-03, which was adopted by the Board of Directors on December 16, 2008, Minute Order 4.1, and its conclusion was that the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Park District leasing the property from RDA is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guideline Section 15301 because the leasing of an existing facility for the use set forth herein is not an expansion of the use beyond that considered in the Negative Declaration.
