### AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

# AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 560.2 PROVIDING FOR LOW-COST, NON-PROFIT, PUBLIC SPAY AND NEUTER CLINICS FOR DOGS AND CATS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection a. of Section 2. of Ordinance No. 560.2 is amended to read as follows:

"a. Any dog: \$85.00"

Subsection b. of Section 2. of Ordinance No. 560.2 is amended to read as follows:

"b. Any cat: \$40.00"

Section 3. A new Section 3. shall be added to Ordinance No. 560.2 as follows:

"Section 3. FEES FOR CONTRACT SPAY AND NEUTER SERVICES

a. Contract Spay and Neuter Clinic Services – full day of service \$6,862.00

b. Contract Spay and Neuter Bus Services – full day of service \$5,285.00"



#### **BACKGROUND:**

which provides for Low-Cost Public Spay and Neuter for dogs and cats.

In accordance with Board of Supervisors policy number B-4, County Departments may evaluate existing rates for services on an annual basis, and make recommendations for changes. The Department last updated rates on July 14, 2009, Agenda Item 9.15. The Department has reviewed the impact of the cost of providing services relative to the rate structure, and is proposing rate changes to specified services provided by the Department of Animal Services and to incorporate and establish a rate for Spay and Neutering Clinic and Bus Services provided by contract.

The proposed rate increases are based on other low-cost clinics within Riverside County that provide Spay and Neutering services to the public. The proposed rates for contract services are based on the cost of providing those services.

The amendment to this Ordinance contains fee revisions, as outlined in Exhibit "A."

#### FINANCIAL DATA

These proposed fees have been reviewed by the County Auditor/Controller. Pending Board of Supervisors approval of the Ordinance, the Department will return with budget adjustments if necessary.

These fees are not based on cost recovery but result in a county subsidy to provide low cost spay and neuter.
