WHEREAS, the hereinafter described portion of 54th Street was offered for dedication for public road and public utility purposes by the document hereinafter-referred to, which offer of dedication has not been previously accepted for public use by the County of Riverside, now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on _____, 2010, that this Board accepts the offer of dedication and recognizes that said road is a public road open for use by the general public;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED that this acceptance is for the purpose of vesting title in the County of Riverside on behalf of the public for public road and utility uses, and is not an acceptance of the road into the County Maintained Road System pursuant to Section 941 of the Streets and Highways Code and that said road will not become part of the County Maintained Road System unless subsequently accepted into said Maintained Road System by a resolution adopted by this Board;

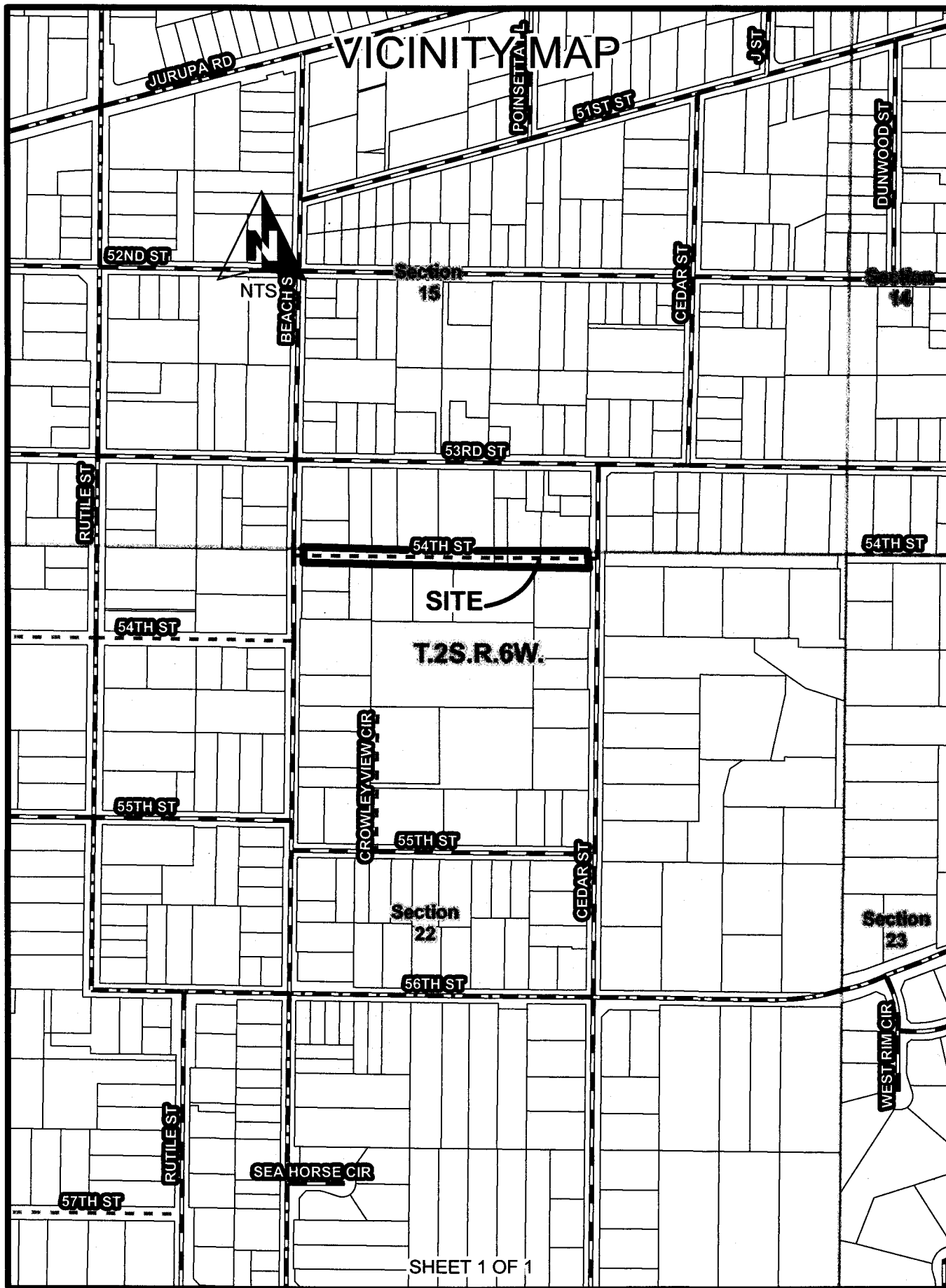
