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**SUBJECT:** Approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Riverside Department of Public Health (DOPH) and Riverside County Superintendent of Schools, Head Start/Early Head Start Programs (HS/EHS).

**BACKGROUND:** The Riverside County Office of Education Head Start/ Early Head Start Programs and the Community Health Agency Department of Public Health have been working together since 2005 to establish working procedures to improve coordination and the provision of health and nutrition related services to Head Start / Early Head Start children and their families.

Both HS/EHS and DOPH serve low-income children 5 years of age and under, as well as their families by providing health and nutrition related services and education. HS/EHS is mandated to provide developmental, sensory, and behavioral screening and follow-up assessment for each child in the program. Further, HS/EHS is required to ensure that children are up to date on an age appropriate schedule of well childcare. HS/EHS must provide health and nutrition education for parents and works with parents to ensure that children access appropriate health care. DOPH provides health and nutrition education as well as direct health services for children and their parents in Riverside County.

The current agreement between both agencies will expire on August 30, 2010. This new agreement will authorize both agencies to continue to work together in reaching their goal of linking children with health care providers in order to ensure early diagnosis, continuous care treatment of conditions and preventive care to promote health.

### **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This agreement is between the County of Riverside, Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health and the Riverside County Superintendent of Schools, Head Start / Early Head Start Programs. This agreement is from September 1, 2010 through August 30, 2015.

#### I. PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to establish a working procedure between the Riverside County Department of Public Health (DOPH) programs and the Head Start / Early Head Start Programs of the Riverside County Office of Education (RCOE) to improve coordination and the provision of health and nutrition related services to Head Start / Early Head Start children and their families.

It is the intent of this agreement to:

- 1. Define services to be provided by each agency
- 2. Ensure that HS/EHS children and their families' needs are met.
- 3. Ensure that open communication and the opportunity to exchange information is maintained by each agency.
- 4. Ensure that cooperative arrangements between HS/EHS and DOPH are developed.

#### II. BACKGROUND

Both HS/EHS and DOPH serve low-income children 5 years of age and under, as well as their families by providing health and nutrition related services and education. HS/EHS is mandated to provide developmental, sensory, and behavioral screening and follow-up assessment for each child in the program. Further, HS/EHS is required to ensure that children are up to date on an age appropriate schedule of well childcare. HS/EHS must provide health and nutrition education for parents and works with parents to ensure that children access appropriate health care. DOPH provides health and nutrition education, as well as direct health services for children and their parents in Riverside County. Both agencies share the goal of linking children with health care providers in order to ensure early diagnosis, continuous care treatment of conditions and preventive care to promote health.
