BACKGROUND: (Continued)

In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, the Tax Collector conducted the November 7, 2005 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded January 9, 2006. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on January 30, 2006, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were—used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received one claim for excess proceeds:

1) Claim from the Law Offices of Philip Putman, assignee for Michael J. Garrigue based on an Assignment of Rights to Claim Excess Proceeds from Sale of Tax Deeded Property dated February 24, 2006, an Assignment of Right to Collect Excess Proceeds dated April 21, 2007, a Grant Deed recorded July 21, 1971 as Instrument No. 80460, an Affidavit Section 13101- Probate Code and the death certificate of Henri Jean Garrique.

Pursuant to Section 4675 (a) & (b) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that the Law Offices of Philip A. Putman, assignee for Michael J. Garrigue be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$10,732.67. Supporting documentation has been provided. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion.
