SUBJECT: Approval of the First Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the City of Menifee

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the First Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the city of Menifee, and authorize the Chairperson to execute the Amendment on behalf of the Board.
- 2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments on the attached Schedule A for the addition of a Deputy Sheriff position.

BACKGROUND: On August 3, 2010, the Mayor of Menifee executed the first amendment to its law enforcement services Agreement with the Sheriff's Department. The amendment modifies the level of service provided by the Sheriff's Department to the city with the addition of a Deputy Sheriff position to fulfill duties as a motor officer.

Based on the July 1st start date for the new service, Department staff estimates the service cost for this contract personnel addition to total \$221,000. All costs for this service will be recovered through Board-approved rates. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

As with other recent modifications to law enforcement contract service levels, staff is not recommending the creation of an additional position in the Sheriff's Department to fulfill this contractual duty; rather, the Department is recommending the use of a previously frozen position.
