along Hamner and Sumner Avenues, and video bike detection (for both bike and vehicles) at several signalized intersections along both routes, which will also improve the efficiency of the signal operations. This project was generated based on community requests to install bike lanes in Eastvale. Both Hamner and Sumner Avenues were selected because these two arterials have adequate width along these segments to accommodate bike lanes without road widening.

The proposed bike lane project on Hamner Avenue will connect Schleisman Road and Limonite Avenue and on Sumner Avenue it will connect Citrus Street to northerly of Limonite Avenue.

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for the traffic signal facilities portion of the work.

County staff has made the new City of Eastvale staff aware of this project and will coordinate with them prior to awarding the contract.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
