

## **BACKGROUND:**

On August 10, 2010, the Board of Directors of the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (RDA) approved the plans and specifications, and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids for the Thermal Water and Sewer Improvements Project. On September 1, 2010, three bids were received; the lowest bid was submitted by Jones Brothers Construction Company.

County Counsel has reviewed all bids and has determined that Jones Brothers Construction Company is the lowest responsible bidder and constitutes a proper basis for award of the contract. Health & Safety Code Section 33445 requires that the Board of Supervisors make required findings and consent to the payments by the Agency. The cost for the Thermal Water and Sewer Improvements Project will be paid entirely from DCPA Capital Improvement Funds and will not impact the County General Funds. Therefore, EDA Staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors make the recommended findings and consent to the payments by the RDA for the project budget which includes an Engineering Services Agreement with Krieger and Stewart, Inc., for engineering services in conjunction with the installation of the water and sewer lines as follows:
