BACKGROUND: On September 18, 2007, the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (Agency) Board of Directors authorized the Executive Director, or designee, to execute a Memorandum of Understanding including Exclusive Right to Negotiate in exchange for Agreement to Assign Purchase and Sale / Escrow (the MOU Agreement) with Urban Housing Communities, LLC (UHC), a California limited liability company.

Under the terms and conditions of the MOU Agreement, Agency and UHC agreed to explore and negotiate in good faith a possible disposition and development agreement, or other agreement satisfactory to the Agency, for the construction and operation of a for sale single-family detached neighborhood for first-time homebuyers and a multi-family affordable housing complex to assist Agency to meet its fair share housing responsibilities.

Agency and UHC mutually desire to terminate the MOU Agreement, and UHC has requested a reimbursement in the amount of \$100,397 for costs incurred for planning and close of escrow.

Agency counsel has reviewed and approved to form the attached termination agreement. Staff recommends that the Redevelopment Agency's Board Directors approve the attached termination agreement.

TERMINATION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND URBAN HOUSING COMMUNITIES, LLC

This Termination Agreement is made and entered into on this _____day of ______, 2010, (the "Effective Date") by and between the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside ("AGENCY"), a public body, corporate and politic and Urban Housing Communities, LLC ("UHC"), a California Limited Liability Company.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2007, AGENCY Board of Directors authorized the Executive Director or designee to execute a Memorandum of Understanding including Exclusive Right to Negotiate in exchange for Agreement to Assign Purchase and Sale / Escrow (the "MOU Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, AGENCY and UHC entered into the MOU Agreement to jointly plan for the development of AGENCY-owned unimproved real property located in Hemet, Riverside County, California; and

WHEREAS, under the terms and conditions of the MOU Agreement, Agency and UHC agreed to explore and negotiate in good faith a possible disposition and development agreement, or other agreement satisfactory to the Agency, for the construction and operation of a for sale single-family detached neighborhood for first-time homebuyers and a multi-family affordable housing complex to assist Agency to meet its fair share housing responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, AGENCY and UHC mutually desire to terminate the MOU Agreement; and

WHEREAS, UHC is waiving its right to notice and cure set forth in Section 11 of the MOU Agreement; and

WHEREAS, UHC has requested a reimbursement in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Seven dollars (\$100,397) for costs incurred for planning and close of escrow.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the preceding promises and the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties hereto do hereby agree as follows:

- The MOU Agreement between AGENCY and UHC is terminated as of the Effective Date of this Termination Agreement.
- 2. AGENCY shall reimburse One Hundred Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Seven dollars (\$100,397) for costs incurred for planning and close of escrow.
- 3. This Termination Agreement is not binding until approved by the Board of Directors.
