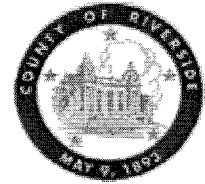

BACKGROUND:

The referenced median along Limonite Avenue, from Cedar Creek Road to Sumner Avenue, was constructed through a change order to the County project entitled "Limonite Avenue Reconstruction project (A5-0267)" to prevent unsafe and illegal vehicular movements through the intersection of Limonite Avenue and Cedar Creek Road. Landscaping was not installed as a part of the median improvements due to commitments for construction completion. Additionally, there was no established landscape maintenance agreement at that time.

Due to strong interest and requests from the Eastvale community for landscaping in the median, to provide visual consistency with the existing median islands directly adjacent to the limit of this project, the Transportation Department developed this project to install landscaping within the subject median island.

Jurupa Community Service District (JCSD) will maintain the median landscape in accordance with the maintenance agreement with the County.

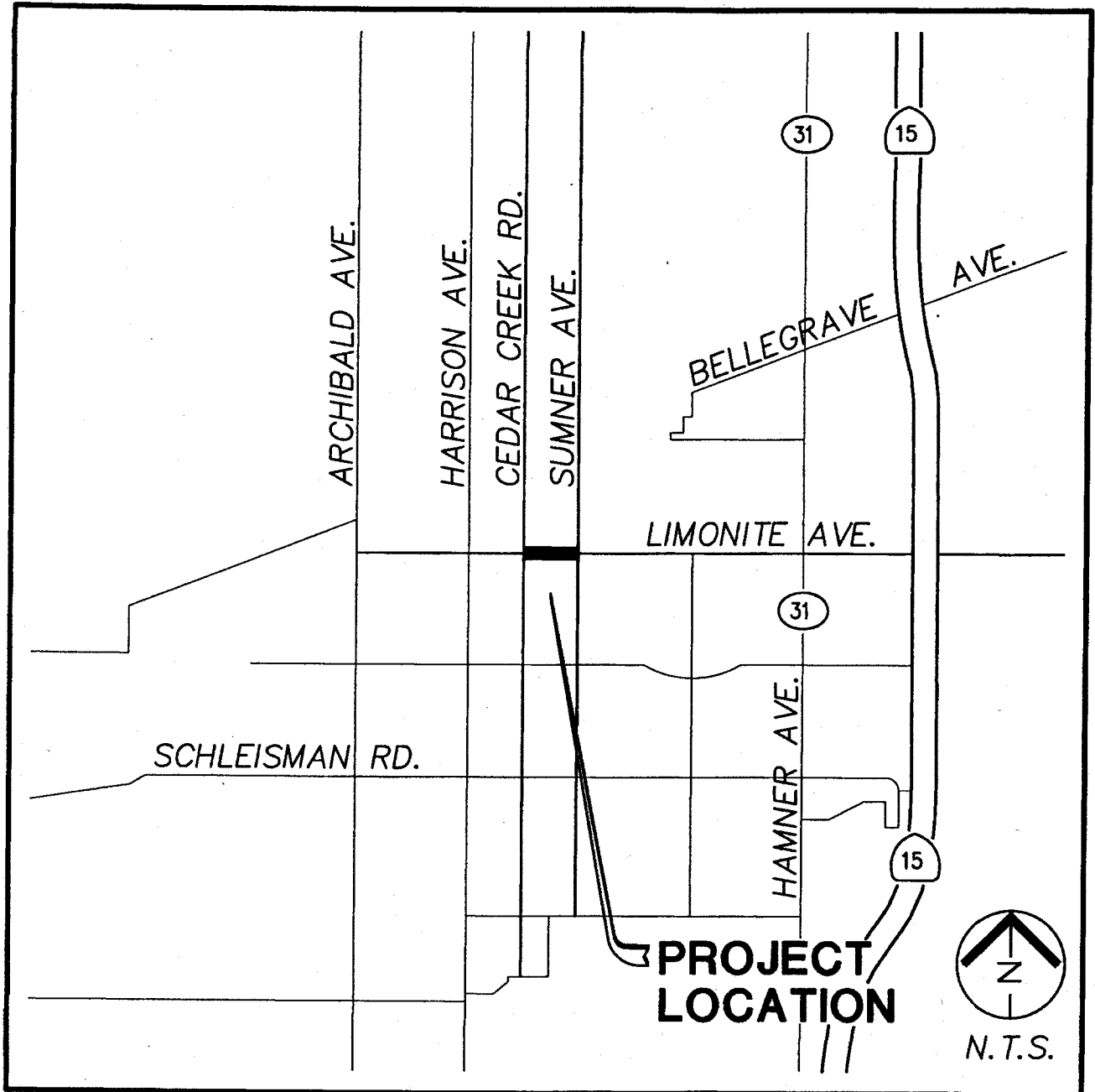
The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
