BACKGROUND:

On July 21, 2009, the Agency entered into an agreement with the engineering firm, David Evans & Associates, Inc., to design the Perret Park Phase II Improvement Project.

The Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside has completed the preparation of plans and specifications of the project.

The project is located East of Grand Avenue, West of Lake Elsinore, on Blackwell Boulevard and Perret Boulevard in the unincorporated community of Lakeland Village. The project consists of the installation of additional picnic shelters, picnic tables, barbeque grills, a canopy over the existing playground to provide shade, and landscaping improvements.

Perret Park provides leisure, recreational, and entertainment opportunities to the residents of the unincorporated community of Lakeland Village and the City of Wildomar. The additional park amenities will assist in creating a more comprehensive community park and accommodate the existing and future recreational needs of the community.

The proposed park improvements are exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15061, General Rule, Section 15301, Class 1-Existing Facilities, and Section 15311 Class 11 – Accessory Structures, a Notice of Exemption was filed with the County Clerk on September 16, 2010, for the 30-day public review period. The project has therefore complied with the provisions of CEQA and no additional environmental analysis is required.

Estimated project cost is \$450,000. A budget for the project will be submitted in the event bids received exceed the estimated project cost. Staff recommends that the Board make the aforementioned findings, consent to the expenditure of redevelopment funds in an amount estimated to be \$450,000, approve the plans and specifications, and authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice of Inviting Bids for the project.
