4. Approve the use of CID funds for the Friends of the Desert Mountains.



BACKGROUND:

The Palm Springs Police Department is hosting a "Gifts for Guns" program in early December. The program will allow residents and business owners the opportunity to turn in weapons in exchange for a gift card at a major retail establishment.

The Virginia Waring International Piano Competition will take place February 20, 2011. The event will support the continuing musical education programs for youth in our local schools.

The YMCA provides childcare and program services throughout the Coachella Valley serving 3200 children each day at 41 sites from the City of Palm Springs to the unincorporated community of Thermal.

The dedication of the Roy Wilson Highway 74 event was hosted jointly by the City of Palm Springs and the County of Riverside. The Friends of the Desert Mountains was responsible for organizing the successful event.
