SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 630.14 amending Ordinance No. 630.13 for the Department of Animal Services

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1) Upon completion of the third reading, adopt Ordinance No. 630.14, with the recommended amendments from the Public Hearing held and closed on August 10, 2010.

BACKGROUND: On February 3, 1987, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 630, establishing regulation of dogs and cats and the related fee schedules, for the Department of Animal Services. In accordance with Board of Supervisors policy number B-4, County Departments may evaluate existing rates for services on an annual basis, and make recommendations for changes. The Department last updated rates on July 14, 2009, Agenda Item 9.11. The Department has reviewed the impact of the cost of providing services relative to the rate structure, and is proposing changes to specified services provided by the Department of Animal Services. BACKGROUND (continued):
