SUBJECT: Acceptance of the FY 2010-11 Automobile Insurance Fraud Program Grant Award and Adoption of Resolution No. 2010-294.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve and ratify acceptance of the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program Grant ("AIF") award from the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California Department of Insurance in the amount of \$337,302 for the grant period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
2. Adopt Resolution No. 2010-294 authorizing the District Attorney to submit an AIF grant application to the California Department of Insurance. The District Attorney shall be authorized to sign the grant agreement for FY 2010-11; however grant agreements for FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 will be submitted to the Board for approval.

BACKGROUND: The Insurance Commissioner of the State of California has renewed the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program grant for the July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 funding period. The grant, awarded under the provision of Section 1872.8 of the California Insurance Code, is to be used by the District Attorney solely for the purpose of enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud cases. The grant award is included in the department's current fiscal year budget. The attached grant award and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

8 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside desires to undertake a certain program designated the
9 Automobile Insurance Fraud Program to be funded by funds made available through and administered
10 by the California Department of Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "DOI"); now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State
12 of California, in regular session assembled on _____, 2010, that the Board of
13 Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California does hereby authorize the District Attorney
14 and/or his designee of the County of Riverside, State of California to submit or sign: Riverside County's
15 application for grant funding for a three year period beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2013;
16 and sign the grant contract for the initial one year period. The contract with DOI for the second and third
17 years shall be approved by the Board of Supervisors. The District Attorney and/or his authorized
18 designee shall sign any contract amendments or extensions that do not significantly change the grant or
19 contract.

20 IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court
21 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The
22 State of California and DOI disclaim responsibility of any such liability.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
24 local expenditures controlled by this body.



This grant award consists of this title page and the application for the grant, which is attached and made a part hereof. By acceptance of the grant award, the grant award recipient agrees to administer the grant project in accordance with all applicable statutes, regulations and Request-for-Applications (RFA).

Duration of Grant: The grant award is for the program period, **July 1, 2010** through **June 30, 2011**.

Purpose of Grant: This grant award is made pursuant to the provisions of California Insurance Code Section 1872.8 and shall be used solely for the purposes of enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud and economic car theft cases.

Amount of Grant: The grant award agreed to herein is in the amount of **\$337,302**. This amount has been determined by the Insurance Commissioner. However, the actual total award amount for the county is contingent on the collection and the authorization for expenditure pursuant to the Government Code Section 13000 et seq. The grant award shall be distributed pursuant to Section 1872.8 of the Insurance Code and to the California Code of Regulations Subchapter 9, Article 4, Section 2698.65.
