Approve and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the attached agreement between the County of Riverside by and through the Transportation Department and Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside, providing \$85,000 in redevelopment funds for the rehabilitation of the Ash Street Road improvement project.

BACKGROUND:

Redevelopment Agency and County of Riverside identified a need to rehabilitate Ash Street between 58th and 59th Street in the unincorporated community of Mira Loma. The project will improve public safety for residents, and improve vehicular traffic flow within the community. The project scope includes construction of a 650 foot by 26 foot roadway on Ash Street between 58th Street and 59th Street.

The attached agreement between Redevelopment Agency and County of Riverside provides \$85,000 in Jurupa Valley Redevelopment Capital Improvement Funds to Riverside County for construction of the project. County Counsel has approved the attached agreement and staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors make the aforementioned findings and approve the agreement to provide funding for the project.
