On November 2, 2010, the Mayor of Moreno Valley executed the third amendment to the city's law enforcement services agreement with the Sheriff's Department. The amendment modifies the level of service provided by the Sheriff's Department to the city with the addition of a Deputy Sheriff position to fulfill duties as a School Resource Officer at Rancho Verde High School.

Based on the December 1st start date for the new service, Department staff estimates the service cost for this contract personnel addition to total \$84,100. All costs for this service will be recovered through Board-approved rates. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND CITY OF MORENO VALLEY

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of its Sheriff's Department, and the City of Moreno Valley, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on December 16, 2008, for services effective July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2013, as amended on December 1, 2009 and November 2, 2010, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:
