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BACKGROUND:

The eight roads in the Rubidoux area, referenced as the Allwood Group, are in poor condition and in need of resurfacing. The work includes removal of the top layer of the damaged asphalt concrete pavement, filling of cracks and placing a new layer of asphalt concrete pavement. Badly damaged concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk will also be removed and replaced. The existing sidewalk access ramps will be reconstructed to current standards. Additional improvements include the installation of new striping, pavement markings, and other related work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
