#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the resurfacing of Pedley Road from Galena Road to SR-60 in the Glen Avon area of Riverside County. The segment of Pedley Road from Jurupa Road to Galena Street is being added based on the current need for improvement. The improvements will include the cold planning of existing pavement surface, construction of concrete curb and gutter, curb ramps, asphalt concrete dike, thermoplastic pavement markings, signing, striping and other associated work.

Portions of the existing pavement surface of Pedley Road have many cracks and are in very poor condition. Roadway resurfacing is a preventive measure and it will mitigate the current deteriorated road conditions. The improvements will benefit the local businesses, residents and users of Pedley Road by providing a safer road surface for travel, as well as improved pedestrian access.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
