RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board of Supervisors appoint Greg Spears, Bill Schoenborn, Steve Heslop, Matt Riha and Michael Mistica to three year terms as members of the Board of Examiners for Backflow and Cross Connection Control.

BACKGROUND:

The Board of Supervisors adopted Riverside County Ordinance No. 525.5 effective June 21, 2007. Section 2 of the ordinance established a five (5) member Board of Examiners, appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The members are appointed for three (3) year terms, not to exceed a collective appointment of ten (10) years.
