SUBJECT: Palm Desert Sheriff Station - Retention Reduction

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve a reduction of the contract retention for ASR Constructors, Inc., of Riverside, California from 10% to 5% per the general conditions of the contract.

**BACKGROUND:** On November 25, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved the award of the construction contract to ASR Constructors, Inc., of Riverside, California. Pursuant to the general conditions of the contract, the Economic Development Agency (EDA) is currently retaining 10% of all progress payments to ASR Constructors. The general conditions of the contract state that after the 50% completion point of the contract work, if satisfactory progress is being made the county has sole discretion to reduce the retention to a minimum of 5% of the contract. ASR Constructors has completed over 98% of the contract work and excellent progress has been made.
