

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**BACKGROUND:**

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the resurfacing of De Luz Road, between Rancho California Road and Carancho Road, and associated improvements in the Santa Rosa area of Riverside County. Roadway resurfacing is a preventive measure and resurfacing is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed road improvements will consist of placing of new asphalt concrete over existing pavement. Additional improvements include replacement of existing asphalt concrete dikes and oversided drains, replace existing corrugated metal pipe storm drain with reinforced concrete pipe storm drain at one location, installation of thermoplastic pavement markings, and striping.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
