**BACKGROUND:** (Continued)

On October 19, 2010, the bids were opened and Pacific Electric Lighting & Sound Inc., dba W.B. Walton Electric was determined to be the lowest responsive bidder.

The Economic Development Agency (EDA) has evaluated the bids received and has found the bids to be economically unviable. EDA is therefore requesting the Board of Supervisors reject all bids and authorize the Clerk of the Board to re-advertise for bids using a reduced scope of the plans and specifications originally approved by the Board of Supervisors. EDA will return to the Board of Supervisors under separate cover to approve the project budget and execute any related project agreements.

All costs associated with this project will be funded through Night Court Funds.
