On October 19, 2010, the bids were opened and Pacific Electric Lighting & Sound Inc., dba W.B. Walton Electric was determined to be the lowest responsive bidder.

The Economic Development Agency (EDA) has evaluated the bids received and has found the bids to be economically unviable.
