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**BACKGROUND:** Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 (RCC Title 15), 348 (RCC Title 17 and 725 (RCC Title 1.16) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Multiple Notices of Violation and Administrative Citations were issued over several years regarding the above-referenced violations. Subsequently, the property owner brought the property into compliance.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Expense has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law.
