- (3) authorize the recordation of a notice of abatement lien; and
- (4) authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment
- (5) authorize and direct the Code Enforcement Department to take any reasonable actions to collect the amount owed.

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BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 (RCC Title 15), 520 (RC Title 10), 348 (RCC Title 17, 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120) and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Seizure warrant MICS 2009-103 was issued and executed to remove the substandard structure, excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish on the property. Seizure warrant MISC 2010-131 was issued and executed to remove twenty-three (23) abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles. Also, seizure warrant MISC 2010-132 was issued and executed to remove additional excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish on the property and inside the abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Expense has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
