BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 520 (RCC Title 10), 457 (RCC Title 15) and 725 (RCC Title 1.16) authorize for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

The Riverside County Code Enforcement Department issued a Notice of Intention to Abate and Remove on Sept. 25, 2009 with regard to CV09-06547 and April 6, 2010 with regard to CV09-06548. On or about June 15, 2010, the abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles were abated from the subject property, under the direction of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department pursuant to seizure warrant number MISC 2010-046. Also, on or about October 29, 2010, the substandard mobile homes / recreational vehicles were abated from the subject property, under the direction of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department pursuant to seizure warrant number MISC 2010-110.

The property has a delinquent tax status as of 2008.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Expense has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
