#### **BACKGROUND:**

By Minute Order dated November 30, 2010 (agenda item 3.61), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the resurfacing of portions of 52nd Avenue and 66th Avenue, and the reconstruction of Washington Street and short segments of Country Club Drive in the Coachella Valley area. Additionally, the specifications were approved by the Board within this agenda item.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and to take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached as Addendum No. 1, and Addendum No. 2.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, December 22, 2010. Five bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest and responsible bid was submitted by Matich Corporation in the amount of \$830,000 which is \$368,800 (30.76%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The project will be completed within the existing budget shown on Attachment "A".





Hours of Work. Refer to Section 17 of the Instructions to Bidders entitled "HOURS OF WORK" page A6. The second paragraph is deleted and replaced with the following paragraph:

"Daily working hours shall be between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., or as revised in the Special Provisions, Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, and as approved by the Engineer. Exceptions and specific work schedules shall be submitted to the Engineer for consideration."





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
