BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 520 (RCC Title 10) and 725 (RCC Title 1.16) authorize for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors

The Riverside County Code Enforcement Department issued a Notice of Intention to Abate and Remove on or about July 13, 2010. On or about Oct. 25, 2010, the abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles were abated from the subject property under the direction of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department pursuant to seizure warrant number MISC 2010-118.

The property has a delinquent tax status as of 2007.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Expense has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
