SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 884.1, An Ordinance of the County of Riverside Amending Ordinance No. 884 Regulating Targeted Residential Picketing

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors introduce and adopt Ordinance No. 884.1 on successive weeks.

BACKGROUND: On February 8, 2011, the Board of Supervisors adopted an order initiating an amendment to Ordinance No. 884 that would reduce from thirty (30) to three (3) feet the distance within which targeted residential picketing is prohibited. The Board also directed the Office of County Counsel to prepare and process the amendment. Ordinance No. 884.1 has been prepared in accordance with that directive.

SUBJECT: Initiation of Amendment to Ordinance No. 884, an Ordinance Regulating Targeted Residential Picketing.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt an order initiating an amendment to Riverside County Ordinance No. 884, reducing the picketing distance prohibition, as further described below; and
2. Direct County Counsel to prepare and process the amendment.

BACKGROUND: The proposed amendment will reduce the distance where targeted residential picketing is prohibited from thirty (30) feet to three (3) feet from the property line. This reduction will better protect the public's First Amendment Rights, while still maintaining the privacy interest of residential occupants and the ability of law enforcement to preserve order.

FISCAL: It will cost approximately \$200.00 to prepare and process the ordinance amendment. The costs of implementing and enforcing the ordinance amendment cannot be accurately estimated as they will vary depending on the number of times the Sheriff's assistance is required.
