Economic Development Agency Initiation of Ordinance Prohibiting Solicitation on County Property February 16, 2011 Page 2

BACKGROUND:

The purpose of this ordinance is to prohibit unauthorized solicitation on County property by any person and to provide for enforcement of the ordinance by public safety personnel. In addition to County employees, the residents of the County and the general public at large regularly use such property for its intended purposes. Unauthorized solicitation on County property may obstruct, interfere or conflict with the use of such property for proper governmental purposes and may create a health and/or safety hazard within, about, or upon such property. This request for initiation, if approved, would authorize the Economic Development Agency to prepare and process the ordinance.

FINANCIAL DATA:

Under Board Policy A-67, the Board of Supervisors is to consider the costs associated with preparing, processing and implementing an ordinance in deciding whether to adopt an order initiating the amendment. The estimated cost of preparing, processing and implementing this ordinance is \$10,000 which will be paid by the Economic Development Agency — Facilities Management budget. The costs of enforcing the ordinance where the assistance from the Sheriff's Department would be warranted is currently undetermined, but conceivably a minimal amount.
