BACKGROUND: On May 4, 2010, the County Board of Supervisors approved Agenda Item 3.59 authorizing the submittal of the California Volunteers State Homeland Security Grant application and designating Authorized Agents to oversee the grant for an amount up to \$150,000.

The California Volunteers Commission has chosen OES as one of the grant recipients and has awarded funding in the amount of \$231,000, \$81,000 more than originally requested. These funds will allow OES to develop, expand and enhance state and local governments' ability to use disaster volunteers through first aid and CPR training, background checks for up to 200 disaster corps volunteers and the purchase of pertinent supplies, equipment, training, exercise and planning activities. Further, it will provide funding for three staffing positions for a period of 11 months who will facilitate these duties.

The grant term is through February 28, 2012 and will be included in the OES FY11/12 budget.

SUBJECT: Adoption of Riverside County Resolution No. 2010-147, to apply for and designate the Authorized Agent through the California Volunteers State Homeland Security Grant Program.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that Reso No. 2010-147, be adopted, authorizing the Riverside County Fire Chief as the Authorized Agent, the Deputy Director of OES and the Auditor-Controller, as alternates in processing and coordinating all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain financial assistance up to \$150,000 provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and subgranted through the California Volunteers Disaster Volunteering and Preparedness Dept.

BACKGROUND: California Volunteers has dedicated \$1.2 million in competitive grant funding for a program that will support development of a cadre of 1,000 Disaster Corps. volunteers and provide 18-month funding for a volunteer coordination position in five Operational Areas. Applicants for the Cal Volunteers Grant Program are required to submit an Authorized Agents and Application Approval Resolution with their Cal Volunteer grant application. Therefore, the attached resolution identifies those individuals who, by title/position, are the designated Authorized Agents for the County of Riverside and who are required to complete transactions to obtain financial aid through the Cal Volunteer Grant Program.
