RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

Statement of Expense [Case Nos. CV 02-1855, CV03-2798 & CV08-01003]
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BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 (RCC Title 17), 457 (RCC Title 15), 541(RCC Chapter 8.120), 520 (RCC Title 10) and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Multiple Notices of Violation were issued with regard to the above-referenced violations. Subsequently, the property owner voluntarily abated the vehicle(s), substandard structure and substandard recreational vehicle(s). Additionally, on or about August 23, 2009, the excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish was abated from the subject property under the direction of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department pursuant to seizure warrant MISC 2009-076.

The Notice of Hearing re Statement of Expense has been posted on the property and mailed to the property owner and all interested parties, as required by law. Copies of all relevant notices issued in this matter together with proof of service and posting have been separately filed with the Clerk of the Board and are made a part of the record herein, pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance 725.
