RE: Paving rehabilitation on the entry drive at Lake Skinner Recreation Area.

March 3, 2011

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**BACKGROUND:** This project will provide maintenance and rehabilitation of approximately 2 miles of the entry drive within the Lake Skinner Recreation Area between Borel Road/Warren Road and the Park Check Stand/Entry Station. Roadway maintenance and rehabilitation is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed road improvements will consist of sealing cracks on the existing pavement, placing asphalt-rubber seal coat, installing roadside signs, pavement markers, thermoplastic traffic stripes and pavement markings, and other associated work as may be required.

On October 5, 2010, item 3.29 and item 13.3, the Board of Supervisors approved the agreement between the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District and Riverside County Transportation Department, for the design, bidding, administration, and construction of improvements by the Transportation Department. The Parks District will provide 100% of the project funding and will be responsible for the maintenance of the facility.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
