
**SUBJECT:** Authorize Transmittal to the County of Riverside Auditor-Controller

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution No. 2011-068, and authorize transmittal to the County of Riverside Auditor-Controller's Office.

**BACKGROUND:** On January 10, 2011, Governor Brown proposed the elimination of all redevelopment agencies throughout the State of California as a component of his budget proposal. Subsequently, on February 23, 2011, the Department of Finance of the State of California released draft legislation that, in Section 6, dissolves redevelopment agencies effective July 1, 2011.

Part 1.85, Chapter 1, Section 34173(2)(B) of the proposed legislation states that *the determination of the first local agency that elects to become the successor agency shall be made by the county auditor-controller based on the earliest receipt by it of a copy of a duly adopted resolution of the local agency's governing board authorizing such an election.*

While Resolution No. 2011-068 authorizes the designation of a Successor Agency pursuant to the proposed legislation, adoption of this resolution does not indicate that the Board of Supervisors has accepted the proposal to eliminate redevelopment. The Board remains opposed to the proposed legislation.

Resolution No. 2011-068 designates the Riverside County Economic Development Agency (EDA) as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside, effective July 1, 2011. The Redevelopment Agency is currently a division of EDA, and therefore is the best equipped to manage the activities related to the gradual cessation of redevelopment activity.

As of this date, the legislation has not been adopted into law. Thus, the designation set forth in Resolution No. 2011-068 shall only become implemented upon adoption of this proposed legislation or a similar version which eliminates redevelopment agencies and requires the designation of a successor agency.

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5 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF  
6 RIVERSIDE DESIGNATING THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT  
7 AGENCY AS THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

10 WHEREAS, on January 10, 2011, Governor Brown proposed the elimination of  
11 all redevelopment agencies throughout the State of California as a component of his  
12 budget proposal;

13 WHEREAS, the Department of Finance of the State of California released draft  
14 legislation on February 23, 2011 that is generally consistent with Governor Brown's  
15 budget proposal;

16 WHEREAS, Section 6 of the proposed legislation dissolves redevelopment  
17 agencies effective July 1, 2011;

18 WHEREAS, Part 1.85, Chapter 1, Section 34171(j), of the proposed legislation  
19 defines "Successor Agency" as the *county, city, or city and county that authorized the*  
20 *creation of each redevelopment agency or another entity as provided in Section 34173;*

21 WHEREAS, Part 1.85, Chapter 1, Section 34173(2)(A), of the proposed  
22 legislation states that *If a city, county, city and county or any member of a joint powers*  
23 *authority that authorized the creation of the redevelopment agency elects not to serve*  
24 *as a successor agency under this part, it shall not receive any property tax allocation*  
25 *from the funds disbursed for the Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund pursuant to*  
26 *paragraph (5) of subdivision (a) and paragraph (4) of subdivision (e) of Section 34183.*  
27 *Instead, that share of property tax shall be allocated to the first local agency in the*  
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1 county that elects to become the successor agency by submitting to the county auditor-  
2 controller a duly adopted resolution of its governing body to that effect;

3 **WHEREAS**, Part 1.85, Chapter 1, Section 34173(2)(B), of the proposed  
4 legislation states that *the determination of the first local agency that elects to become*  
5 *the successor agency shall be made by the county auditor-controller based on the*  
6 *earliest receipt by it of a copy of a duly adopted resolution of the local agency's*  
7 *governing board authorizing such an election;*

8 **WHEREAS**, this resolution does not indicate that the Board of Supervisors has  
9 accepted the proposal to eliminate redevelopment and remains opposed to the  
10 proposed legislation; and,

11 **WHEREAS**, in anticipation of the adoption of the proposed or similar legislation  
12 the Board of Supervisors wishes to designate the Riverside County Economic  
13 Development Agency as the Successor Agency for the Redevelopment Agency for the  
14 County of Riverside.

15 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors:

16 **Section 1. Designation of Successor Agency.** The Riverside County Board of  
17 Supervisors designates the Riverside County Economic Development Agency as the  
18 Successor Agency for the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside. This  
19 designation shall not be implemented until the proposed or similar legislation requiring  
20 designation of a successor agency is enacted into law.

21 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect as of July 1, 2011.

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
