BACKGROUND: On February 1, 2008, the Riverside area was awarded the designation of an Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The Riverside UASI Region designation includes the cities of Riverside, San Bernardino and Ontario, as well as the Counties of Riverside and San Bernardino. The County of Riverside received a FY 08 UASI 17, 2009 (3.63).

## **BACKGROUND:**

The UASI program provides financial assistance to address the unique multidisciplinary planning, operations, equipment, training and exercise needs of highthreat, high density urban areas, and to assist the areas in building and sustaining capabilities to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism and weapons of mass destruction.

On March 11, 2011, the County of Riverside was awarded an augmentation to the FY 08 subaward in the amount of \$17,000. Equipment purchases must be completed no later than April 4, 2011. The intent of the award to the Sheriff's Department's Hazardous Device Team is to enhance regional preparedness and expand Improvised Explosive Device (IED) mitigation collaboration efforts within the region.

There are no additional grant agreements to execute associated with acceptance of this award augmentation.
