RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Directors approve a reduction of the contract retention for Edge Development, Inc. from 10% to 5% per the general conditions of the contract.

BACKGROUND: On June 23, 2009, the Board of Directors approved and awarded the contract to Edge Development for the construction of the Marion V. Ashley Community Center. Pursuant to the general conditions of the contract, the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (RDA) is currently retaining 10% of all progress payments to Edge Development, Inc. The general conditions of the contract state that after the 50% completion point of the contract work, if satisfactory progress is being made, RDA has sole discretion to reduce the retention to a minimum of 5% of the contract.
