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BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 (RCC Title 15), 348 (RCC Title 17) and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) and Section 1618, Article 10, Title 25 of the California Code of Regulations, provide authority for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.
