RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve the District's contribution towards the Southern California Stormwater Committee Stormwater Task Force by authorizing a contribution toward the project in the total amount of \$5,000.

BACKGROUND:

The Southern California Water Committee (SCWC) is a nonprofit, nonpartisan public education partnership of businesses, governments, water agencies, agriculture and public interests dedicated to educating Southern Californians about the region's water needs and our state's water resources. The SCWC formed the Regional Stormwater Task Force (Task Force) in January 2011. The purpose of the Task Force is to develop regional consensus-based strategies and recommendations for utilizing stormwater effectively as a new local water supply, and reduce the urban runoff water pollution problems within Southern California.

BACKGROUND (CONTINUED)

The Task Force proposes to meet monthly over the next year to develop recommendations for regional opportunities to capture and utilize stormwater more effectively as a local water supply source compatible with existing watershed plans. The Task Force will also evaluate flood control, water rights and water quality issues and problems associated with stormwater capture and use.

The Contribution will support SCWC staff administration of the Task Force effort. The Task Force projects will assist the District with developing its water conservation mission and also assist with meeting requirements contained in the NPDES MS4 Permits to evaluate opportunities to capture and re-use stormwater as a pollution prevention measure.
