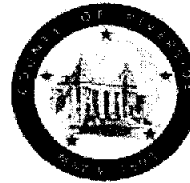

SUBJECT: Waiver of Lake Cahuilla Park Fee for the Desert Mirage High School Cross Country Team.


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Regional Park and Open-Space District to waive the use fee of the facility for the Desert Mirage High School Cross Country Team.

BACKGROUND:

The Desert Mirage Cross Country Training Team would like to have access to Lake Cahuilla Park to train for the period from August 2011 to November 2012. The students will use the facility one time a week and host a cross country meet that will include six high schools and have approximately 100 people in attendance. The total estimated waived cost is approximately less than \$1000.00. The high school program has a limited budget and is unable to cover this cost.

There is minimal impact to the park by this use and it is an idea location for cross county training purposes.

We would like to support our young people in their efforts to exercise and to encourage the use of this park by the surrounding community.
