**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of the Business Improvement and Innovation Grant from the Hemet/San Jacinto Chamber of Commerce

**BACKGROUND:**

The Hemet/San Jacinto Chamber of Commerce, through the Business Improvement and Innovation Grant, seek to encourage networking, participation and outreach to the business community in the valley. The goal of the grant is to cultivate, support, promote and preserve the business community, as well as to encourage and provide opportunities for business development and expansion.

The Department of Public Social Services submitted a grant proposal to the Hemet/San Jacinto Chamber of Commerce to fund "The Book Nook" at the GAIN Resource Center in Hemet. DPSS was awarded the grant in the amount of \$1,000.00 for the project.

The Book Nook library project will be an additional resource available for adults to engage in reading, enhance their reading skills, and to practice business/professional writing. This project will allow DPSS GAIN customers access to books, online tutorials, computerized programs, and writing tools in a professional environment. The library will be used in conjunction with the DPSS Job Readiness Courses offered through GAIN.
