RE: Mountain View Road shoulder widening and striping safety project from Varner Road to Club House Drive, Desert Hot Springs area.

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This safety project will widen the paved shoulders on Mountain View Road a distance of 1.8 miles from Varner Road to Club House Drive, install left turn pockets, resurface portions and provide enhanced striping and pavement markers. The work includes widening the pavement on both sides by an average of 4' for a total width of 36' and providing a 4' graded shoulder on each side. The project will also provide pavement widening for left turn pockets at 20th Avenue east, 20th Avenue west and Club House Drive.

This project is primarily funded by a Federal Highway Administration grant under the "High Risk Rural Roads (HR3) Program".

The County was successful in obtaining FHWA funds through a competitive process. This project will create construction jobs, improve the traffic operation and improve roadway safety.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
