SUBJECT: Reduction of Lake Cahuilla Park Fee for the Desert Mirage High School Cross Country Team.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors authorize the General Manager of the Regional Park and Open Space District to negotiate a reduction of the Lake Cahuilla Park fee for the Desert Mirage High School Cross Country Team.

BACKGROUND:

The Desert Mirage High School Cross Country Team would like to have access to Lake Cahuilla Park to train for the period from August 2011 to November 2012. The students will use the facility one time a week and host a cross country meet that will include six high schools and have approximately 100 people in attendance. The park is an ideal location for cross county training and will be minimally impacted by these activities. The high school program has a limited budget and is unable to cover the full cost of using the park.

The fee reduction will support our young people in their efforts to exercise and will encourage the use of the park by the surrounding community.
