Eligible grant recipients are California's 58 Operational Areas.

BACKGROUND (Continued):

As defined in Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 (as amended through 533.5), "Operational Area means an intermediate level of the state emergency services organization, consisting of a county and all political subdivisions within the county area." OES applies for EMPG funding on behalf of the Riverside County Operational Area (OA). Although the Signature Authority for EMPG has already been established, we are required to provide a new Signature Authority Resolution with each year's application. EMPG funds are awarded to eligible agencies throughout the OA through an application that represents the consensus of the Riverside County Operational Area Planning Committee (OAPC), which consists of Riverside County agencies and jurisdictions. Each agency that is awarded funding will be responsible for providing the 50% cash or in-kind match requirement.
